Check-In Procedure

Artists are required to arrive at check-in within their assigned window. Artists should also complete load-in within this window, so be sure to arrive as early in your check-in time slot as possible.

Check-in is located at the McConnell Arts Center (777 Evening St., Worthington, OH 43085.) Artists should pull into the check-in area from the Evening Street entrance to the McConnell Arts Center. Signs in the lot will direct you where to go from there.

Artists must provide an ID at check-in that matches the application materials submitted to ZAPP. Failure to do so will result in removal from the festival. This is done to prevent buy/sell work.

The check-in team will provide you with an information packet, map, directions to your quadrant and booth, parking pass, and **load-in pass**. Load-in passes should be immediately displayed in your window and will be required to pull onto the load-in zone. This is to ensure only artists have access to the Village Green Drives for load-in.



Load-In Procedure

Your booth will be located on one of four quadrants. Volunteers at check-in will give you directions to the correct quadrant. You must display your load-in pass in the windshield of your vehicle. These passes are color coded to match your group time slot. At the end of your time slot, your vehicle must be moved from the load-in zone on the Village Green to accommodate the next wave of artists. This will be closely monitored. Artist parking will be located just north of the park at Worthington Kilbourne Middle School (Friday only.) An important note for the 4:00pm-5:00pm load-in time on Friday is that all vehicles must be moved off of the Village Green drives by 5:00pm.

There will be a limited number of volunteers available to assist with load-in for large works or those with a physical impairment. Accommodations will be made based on need and advance notice.



Booth Set Up

Booths must be weighted with 40+ pound weights **per leg** to protect from high winds. There is absolutely NO staking permitted on the Village Green. MAC staff will enforce proper weighting. Tents that are not properly weighted must be lowered until weights are installed.

Parking

Artist parking will be available behind Worthington Kilbourne Middle School on Friday during load-in. Artist parking will be available at the MAC on Saturday and Sunday. It is a .3 mile/7 minute walk from the MAC to the Village Green park. Additionally, there is available street parking very close to the Village Greens as well, that may be closer that the MAC parking lot. Please follow all street parking signs when parking on the street. ADA Accessible parking will be behind the middle school on Saturday and Sunday. Handicap placards will be required to park in this lot.

Check-Out Procedure

Artists are not permitted to check out early except in emergency cases. Leaving early without express permission will result in disqualification from all future shows.

Check-out begins at 5:00 PM on Sunday. Artists will need to break down and pack all work before bringing their vehicle to the Village Green. Volunteers will be checking booths and handing out load-out passes. You may only drive back onto the Village Green for load out if you have a pass (meaning your booth was checked.)

Volunteers and staff will do everything possible to ensure a smooth load-out. Because everyone will be leaving at once, we appreciate your patience as we ensure everyone's safety during load-out.

Booth Assignment

Booths are assigned with an effort to spread out artists of different mediums and requested load-in times. Due to our relocation to the Village Green, booths will once again be in rows instead of quads. There is a ~2 foot gap between and behind booths for storage. Please respect your fellow artists and their space. Accommodations to your location will be made only for physical or accessibility needs. Booth assignments are subject to change.

Signage in Booths

The MAC will provide signage that **must** be displayed in every booth for the purpose of judging. Signs should be displayed in the top right corner of the façade of your booth. Signage and zip ties will be passed out at check-in.



Services Available

Camping – artists may camp in the McConnell Arts Center parking lot only if they have notified the McConnell Arts Center by June 1 and must display a camping pass. The Worthington Police will be monitoring the site and checking for passes. Email lisanti@mcconnellarts.org or call 614-431-0329 and ask for "Lindsay" to reserve a pass. (No need to email or call if you have already indicated your plans to camp in the artist survey). Because security will now be patrolling the Village Green, the MAC will not be open overnight this year. The closest campsite is Alum Creek State Park – you can find more information and reservations here https://ohiodnr.gov/go-and-do/plan-a-visit/find-a-property/alum-creek-state-park-campground

Restrooms – Indoor restrooms will be available at the Griswold Center (located on the northwest quadrant) and portable restrooms will be available on the northeast, southeast, and southwest quadrants.

Security – Security will be watching the grounds Friday evening through Saturday morning (5:00PM-8:00AM) and Saturday evening through Sunday morning (5:00PM-11:00AM). The McConnell Arts Center is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

Water – In an effort to reduce plastic waste, we will not be providing water bottles this year. There is a water bottle refill station on the southwest quadrant, a water fountain in the Griswold on the northwest quadrant, a water cooler in the MAC tent on the southeast quadrant, and at the Worthington Chorus booth on the northeast quadrant. Please bring your own reusable water bottles!

Hospitality Room – There is a hospitality room in Griswold Center. Water, coffee, and outlets for charging will be available here. You will need to wear your artist lanyard, given at check-in, to access this room.

Booth Sitters – Booth sitters will be available to watch your booth throughout the festival to allow for breaks. Booth sitters will only be present during the festival's open hours.

- You will be connected with an organizer who will send a sitter to your tent as soon as possible. While we try to have plenty of sitters available, there may be a small wait based on quantity of requests.

Weather

The safety of our artists, patrons, and staff is the number one priority for the MAC/WAF staff. In the case of dangerous, inclement weather (lightning, high winds, flooding), we ask that artists come into the Griswold Center building for safety. If severe weather is forecasted in advance, the MAC will make a decision on festival closure or cancellation. **This decision will be based entirely on the safety of our artists and patrons.** The MAC is not responsible for any damages caused by inclement weather. All notifications regarding weather related closures or schedule changes will be sent via email to the address provided on ZAPP.
